Revised Covid-19 Protocols January 2024



The following plan will be instituted at Trū as the SARS-CoV-2 virus continues to occur frequently in the local community. The goal of this plan is NOT to completely prevent the spread of Covid at Trū, but to **reduce the possibility of disruptions to the student experience**. As levels of infection decline, some precautions may be lifted.

Masks will be optional for all staff and students. N-95 or equivalent masks are highly recommended. Air purifiers are running in the classrooms. In the event of a Covid exposure on campus, a temporary mask requirement will be adopted.

Rapid antigen testing for Covid-19 may occur during periods of high prevalence of the Covid virus in wastewater monitoring. Parents will be notified in advance of this testing.

Isolation protocols will follow state guidelines (which may be <u>viewed here</u>). This guidelines may be summarized briefly as follows:

Person with Covid-19 symptoms	Test for Covid; stay home until symptoms subside
Person with positive close contact	Wear mask for ten days, test within 5 days if symptoms are present
Person who tests positive	Wear mask for ten days; stay home if symptoms are present
